- \$1000: All international students are required to obtain an I-20 from the Academy, which includes a non-refundable \$1000 processing fee (applicable towards tuition and refundable only if the student is denied the visa from their home country, upon which the \$1000 fee is refunded, less processing costs)
- Required to have a debit card for spending money which parents/guardians replenish as needed.
