Sr. Gabriel has been assigned as the Art teacher at St. John School in Old Saybrook, CT in keeping with the presence of the Sisters there after a vacancy. Travel Arrangements and Transportation to AHF

1. The Academy will provide free transportation to and from T. F. Greene Airport, (PVD) Rhode Island; Bradley International Airport, (BDL) Hartford, CT; Framingham Bus Terminal-Logan Express in Framingham, MA, the New London Train Station and the New London Ferry on the first day of school and last day of school before each vacation period, on the day a three day weekend begins, on the day a three day weekend ends, and on the last day of vacation before classes begin. Airport transportation should be made for afternoon flights. We have a limited number of drivers, who also have dorm duties. Please note that the earliest the Sisters can arrive at the airport/train stations is 9am and the latest is 8pm.
2. No staff member will go to pick up or drop off a student between the hours of 9 p.m. and 7 a.m. If a student makes flight arrangements during these hours, the student is responsible to pay for taxi service. Taxi service to the airport is approximately \$150. Private transportation arrangements such as Uber would be up to the family's discretion.
3. It is extremely important that all travel arrangements must be emailed in advance to Sister M Rafael (smraf@ahfbaltic.org) by no later than Saturday August 26.
4. For Orientation Day, we ask that you bring a snack to share with the rest of the school, preferably something unique to your part of the world. It doesn't have to be a lot, just something to give a taste.

The Opening theme this year is "Walking Together." In preparation for Orientation Day, please send Sister M Rafael (smraf@ahfbaltic.org) a picture of your feet and separately a head shot. The foot shot can be with bare feet or shoes. We look forward to walking with you this year.
