End of the Year Travel Arrangements

Students must make ground travel (train) arrangements no earlier than 2 p.m. on June 4 (provided they do not have an exam on June 5), 2025. Flights must leave no earlier than 4pm. Anyone traveling on June 5th or 6th must make their departure times between 11 a.m. and 2 p.m.

We provide transportation on directly to TF Green International Airport (PVD) in Providence (Warwick), RI, and Bradley International Airport (BDL) in Windsor Locks (Hartford), CT. For flights departing from Logan International Airport (BOS) in Boston, the students will need to board the Logan Express bus for Framingham, MA. We only provide transportation to Framingham, not Logan airport. Please be sure to email all travel arrangements for the end of the year departures to Sr. Rafael (smraf@ahfbaltic.org). Please be aware that any travel arrangements outside of the dates provided will be the responsibility of the parents and guardians, and other transportation methods (Uber, taxi, etc.) must be made. We thank you for your constant presence, guiding us through moments of learning, growth, and community.


Eless our students, may they carry the values instilled in them, as they continue to pursue knowledge, embrace the truths of Christ, and respond to the needs of others.
